the verve

The Verve were once described by Oasis's Noel Gallagher as Britain's number two band (no prizes for who he said took the top spot).

Since releasing their debut album back in 1993, the foursome who are currently Wigan's most famous sons have been called "Oasis with lyrics" and "the Stone Roses with a proper singer".

The singer, Richard Ashcroft, who was dubbed "Captain Rock" by Noel Gallagher, views the band in a different light. He sees them as the new "Led Zeppelin".

The Verve, comprising singer Richard Ashcroft, guitarist Nick McCabe, bass man Simon Jones and drummer Peter Salisbury, first formed in 1990. Their first album, "A Storm In Heaven", was not a sell-out, but Ashcroft never had any doubts.

The name of the group actually came from the American jazz label "Verve", who suggested the

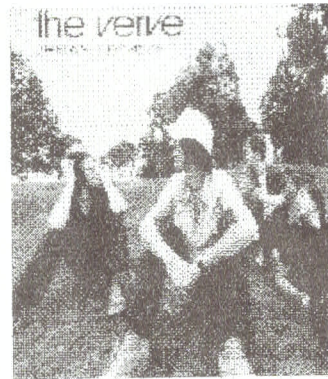
name change to avoid confusion. From that day on the four lads were known as "The Verve".

After a debut US tour and the usual round of Euro-festivals, The Verve collected themselves together in late 1994 to record the all-important second album "A Northern Soul". It hit the streets in 1995, and boasted three chart singles. Ashcroft told people that the album was "one character going through twelve different experiences of pain, elation, sex, loss, romance...all the emotions piled on to one album".

But instead of pursuing greater success, the band split up and went their own ways in the summer of 1995, and that was it from The Verve. Or was it? In the summer of 1997, they got back together, and hits like "Bittersweet Symphony", and "The Drugs Don't Work" appeared. Finally along came "Urban Hymns", the long awaited third album. The album was a huge success, staying in the charts for a long time, and coming in second in the Target Survey 1997 in our last issue.

However, they encountered problems with the law, when lawyers arrived suggesting that they should lose their royalties because they sampled a string and

bell loop from Andrew Loog Oldham's orchestral arrangement of the song "The Last Time" by the



Rolling Stones. If you have the album, look at the composer credits for Bittersweet Symphony - see?

The links between The Verve and Oasis go back to the "A Storm In Heaven" tour when Wigan's finest invited Manchester's up-and-coming group to support them. Ashcroft and Noel Gallagher even swapped musical compliments: "Cast No Shadow" was written about Ashcroft, and The Verve apparently wrote "A Northern Soul" upon hearing about Gallagher's hasty departure from the 1994 Oasis US tour. The alliance continued last year when The Verve, while off on their own headline tour, agreed to support Oasis on their sell-out Earls Court dates.

Boro v Newcastle - FA Cup 4th round

at Broadhall Way, final result 1-1. Match report by Ian Albon.

It all started on 4th January, Kevin Keegan drew the home side, "Stevenage Borough". Then the opponents were drawn, "Newcastle United". What was to follow would be both controversial and exciting.

To start with the match was to be played at St James Park until Sky Sports offered to screen the match but only if it was at Broadhall Way. After this the 'Boro' chairman Victor Green did everything in his power including paying for temporary seating to be put up to accommodate the 'Toon Army'. However Newcastle protested that the new seating would not be safe so they appealed to the F.A. There appeal was thrown out. Every news broadcast seemed to have the Stevenage story on it so did the newspapers and the match was even being shown in Kenya! The tickets finally became on sale on the 18th January, members of the public had been camping overnight to get a ticket while season ticket holders and supporters association members had first choice.

So to match day January 25th, the turnstiles opened at 2:30 but people had been queuing at least an hour before to get in. The atmosphere was tremendous, by far the best I've heard all season and the roar of the crowd could be heard all around Stevenage.

The match started off badly for 'Boro' when on 3 minutes a mistake from Michael Love gave Gillespie the ball, he ran down the Newcastle right and crossed the ball into the box to be met by the head of Alan Shearer. This was his first goal since his return. But

after this Stevenage showed great courage to fight back into the game. Both Jason Soloman and Steve Perkins hit shots which just went wide. Newcastle then fought back with a deflected Shearer free kick just wide. 'Boro's' first real chance was on 25 minutes when a free kick from Simon Stapleton was

with both sides only really having one chance each. On 63 minutes Mark Smith put a long ball to Trebble who flicked it onto to Crawshaw whose volley ended up in Hislop's arms. Newcastle's chance came on 68 minutes when Gillespie's corner was headed wide by Howey. Towards the end of the

flicked onto to Giuliano Grazioli Who's shot was tipped over by Hislop. Then came an explosive 10 minutes when on 32 minutes a cross from Neil Trebble was met by the boot of Grazioli who directed it into the back of the net. However Grazioli was given offside and the goal was disallowed. Two minutes later a Perkins defensive clearance was met by an overhead kick from Grazioli. The ball fell to Gary Crawshaw who was denied a goal by a brilliant save from Hislop who was diving to his left. Newcastle should have gone 2-0 up when on 37 minutes another header from Shearer was saved by Des Gallagher. Then at last on 40 minutes a Stapleton cross was met by the head of Trebble whose header was tipped over. Crawshaw stepped up to take the corner which was headed in by none other than the hero at Swindon Grazioli. Stevenage had equalised. Newcastle could have regained the lead when on half time Gillespie crossed the ball but the volley from 4 yards by Shearer was hit over. Shearer was having a particularly bad game.

The second half was not as good as the first

match the crowd were eagerly awaiting the final whistle from the referee Peter Jones. At last the whistle arrived and some of the fans invaded the pitch to start the celebrations. When the pitch was cleared Stevenage did a lap of honour. However the celebrations were spoilt by news that Love had broke a bone in his foot and that some of the Newcastle players notably Alan Shearer walked off the pitch without shaking hands with any Stevenage players. Yoyu would have thought they would have entered into the spirit of things. Also amazingly Kenny Dalglish blamed the draw on the ball being too bouncy! The replay is set to be quite a match with the winners playing Tranmere.

Boro V Newcastle

FA Cup 4th round replay. Match report by Andrew Coates.

For the 1800 Boro fans that made the 800 mile round trip to St. James's Park, they were rewarded by an excellent performance by Boro. Boro worked hard to pull themselves back into it. They had a few chances just before the break, with Beevor pulling a shot across goal, Crawshaw just failing to meet a curling cross by Trebble and Wordsworth shooting inches wide from 20 yards out on the stroke of half-time. Newcastle had opened the scoring on 16 minutes though with a highly disputed goal. Pistone had been put free down the left to cross for Shearer to head towards goal. Smith made an acrobatic goalline clearance which replays show had kept the ball from going over the line 67 The goal stood, though, and Boro were one down. The second half was more open with many goal opportunities. Boro keeper Gallagher made some excellent saves, holding a fierce Shearer free-kick and palming



away another from Pearce. Newcastle went two up when Rob Lee was put through on 65 minutes to cross for Shearer to head home. Boro refused to lie down and pulled one back to the delight of the Boro fans on 76 minutes, though, when Inman's deflected cross fell for Crawshaw to Volley home. This led to some nervous minutes to follow for Dalglish & Co, but

players and manager didn't do the same.

The after-match comments left a lot to be desired, such as "we hope they get beat in their trophy match." From Kenny Dalglish, and he never once congratulated Stevenage on two performances a Premier League club would have been happy with against one of the best sides in the country.

The Boro fans had a happy 6-hour ride

Boro couldn't add a second to send it to extra time. Barton missed for Newcastle from 5 yards, which would have settled it for the Geordies. The Boro fans were still singing twice as loud as the Geordies however, and nothing was going to stop them on a great night they will remember always. The final whistle triggered a standing ovation from the Boro fans, and many Newcastle fans stayed to applaud the brave Giant-killers. It's a shame the Newcastle

home, knowing Boro had destroyed the myth that the magic of the worlds best cup competition was dead. Arriving home at 4 in the morning did little to dent their spirits.
